

Natural Born Citizen explained via the Child Analogy

my child = American citizen (generic labels)

my adopted child = naturalized American citizen

my natural child = natural American citizen

my child from birth = an American “citizen from birth”

“from birth” & “at birth” = a starting point in Time

my child by birth = an American citizen by birth

"by birth" = a point of origin, natural origin

My child from birth = a child adopted at birth

A citizen from birth = a citizen naturalized at birth

my child by birth = my natural born child

A citizen by birth = a natural born citizen

a natural born child = a natural born American citizen

my child from birth \neq my child by birth

a citizen from birth \neq a citizen by birth

a citizen by birth \neq a citizen naturalized at birth

an American-produced child \neq an alien-produced child

an American-produced citizen \neq an alien-produced citizen

an alien-produced citizen = a native-born citizen

a native-born, alien-produced citizen \neq a natural born citizen

a home-born child \neq a natural born child if born to guest residents

a native-born citizen \neq a natural born citizen if born to guest residents
(immigrants)
